UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. WORK ORDER STATUS

- A. TOWN PARK Public Works continues to monitor and tighten chimes as needed.
- B. TOWN PARK Re-sanding of the 5-12 playground area on hold made part other work.
- C. 159th St Triangle PARKING Town Clerk Missy Clarke speaking to Lynn Burnett Storm Water project not included in Phase One or Two fiscal year 2021, 2022. Best project estimate start 2023. Obtaining pilings to rope off the area is being handled by Dave Poole. Recommendation by Town Clerk Miss Clarke to delay area beautification until drainage is resolved. Noted by Commissioner Steiermann pilings are 6 inch in diameter. Additional investigation being done to determine source of water puddling. David Will reported 20 pilings would be needed spacing about 10 feet apart. Rich Cariello to contact Ron with updating information, advising him we are addressing parking situation with posts but beautification will not take place until 2022, 2023. Public Works.
- D. TOWN PARK handicap gate entrance has been reinstalled by Public Works. Completed.

- E. BEACH PARK bench COVID-19 spacing completed but location of benches keeps getting moved by the public. The spacing will be monitored by Public Works. Completed.
- F. 4th St Cul de Sac trimming has been done awaiting town inspection. Completed.
- G. Bob Kahn grass edging entry corrected to Friendship Park. Completed.
- H. Reinstall excise equipment in Town Park. Completed.
- I. TRIMMING OF MANGROVES: Town Clerk Missy Clarke spoke to Prime Scape and there is no permit needed or fee. Cutting allowed Mangroves by 25% which is a height of 6 feet and removing Sea Grapes and salt plant quote of \$1200. Payment will be made part of Friendship Park renovation General Budget. Completed.
- J. Memorial Rocks located in Town Park have been secured. Completed
- K. No Dogs Allowed sign replacement for Town Park. Signs ordered.
- L. BIKE RACK recycling grant funding.

Fabricator has been on site and quote is expected shortly.

4. FRIENDSHIP PARK PERGOLA

Based on Town Clerk Missy Clarke's report we do not have any desirable options other than Clark Lighting. Kris Johnson will get contract renewal information with Angels as the lights.

7. TOWN PARK SIGNS: Sign Company has not been reached. Tabled until information about the sign is obtained.
