1. Work Order Status

3. Friendship Park

- A. Garden Club Project
Toni Scarr from Garden Club to purchase red roses for the 9/11 Memorial area. Plan is to remove pentas and plant the roses. Dave Poole from Public Works voiced concerns regarding shade in the area d/t the palm trees.
- B. Plantings and Groundcover
Silver Buttonwood and shell to be placed in the open area by the rocks near the intercoastal canal.
Dave from Public Works to recommend native plants that tolerate shade for former Butterfly Garden area.
Mulch to be placed by the 9/11 Memorial and around tree near the Memorial.
Shell to be placed by bench area.
Shell to be placed under Oaks.

4. Holiday Lights

Refer to Holiday Lighting Contract Notes provided by Kris Johanson
Board majority vote to evaluate new lighting display with Clark's for the 2022 year and beyond. 3 choices selected, Nativity Star P395/Z Tree P121/Loop Tree P645, as potential options. Kris will obtain pricing quotes from Lee for next meeting. Possible community survey to follow in RBPOA.

New Business

1. Ross from 202 160th Terrace, Redington Beach approached the Board regarding the state of the volleyball net in Friendship Park. Concerns included the safety of the net/poles and lack of regulation height of the net. Dave from public works will provide a temporary measure to address safety by pouring another post with concrete, setting a new 4 by 4, with hooks, but still won't be regulation height.
2. Tiffany Terracciano suggested consideration of a pickle ball court for Town Park. Board determined this could be considered in the 2022 budget.
3. Tiffany Terracciano suggested Park Board Member attend each commission meeting. Action deemed not necessary as a Commissioner attends each Park Board meeting.
