Unfinished Business

1. Work Order Status

- A. 163rd and Beach: Replace sand at boardwalk entryway. Status pending. Dave from Public Works is working with Town Clerk Missy to obtain quotes for 3 new boardwalks at 158th, 161st, and 163rd. Plan to present to Commission for budgeting at a future date while grant and approval pending. Purpose of this project is to prevent erosion.

2. Town Park

A. Pole Lights

Board unanimously agreed to table further discussion of pole lights. Board determined it was not a priority at this time, but plans to revisit this topic later.

B. 5-12 Playground Equipment

Town of Redington Beach lawyer is putting together RFP. Once completed, this will be presented to Park Board, as well as public for vendor bidding. Commission budget meeting tonight, 9/13/21, for final reading. Voting/Approval scheduled for 9/15/21 Commission meeting. Work to begin after October 1, 2021.

- A. Plantings and Groundcover
Public works confirmed groundcover to be Oak Leaf Hydrangea. Dave Poole, Public Works, to complete project this week.

4. Holiday Lights

After discussion regarding holiday lights contract occurred among Board members, Board unanimously agreed to continue holiday lighting contract with Clark, the current vendor, with a new 5-year contract with a rate increase of 13.5%. This decision was based on Clark having the most favorable rate increase, as well as community goodwill in keeping the angel design. Placement of angel lighting TBD.

5. 2021-2022 Budget

Final reading of budget tonight at Commission meeting, with scheduled vote/approval of budget on 9/15/21.

New Business

1. Memorial Bench at Beach Park

Francesca P. requests on behalf of her family, long-time Redington Beach residents, a new bench on the dry sand area of Beach Park as a memorial bench for her nephew, Carter. Further requests include that the bench plaque remain solo on this bench. Board determined there is one bench on dry sand area without a plaque. Chairperson Tiffany Terracciano will determine if a plaque can be put on this bench and/or if this bench could be replaced with a newer bench, per the resident request. If unable to accommodate, resident was offered a picnic table memorial at Moon Park.
