Unfinished Business

1. Work Order Status

- A. 163rd and Beach: Replace sand at boardwalk entryway. Status pending. Dave Poole, Public Works, is working with Town Clerk Missy to obtain quotes for 3 new boardwalks at 158th, 162nd, and 163rd. Plan to present to Commission for budgeting

at a future date while grant (State of Florida-DEP) and approval pending. Purpose of this project is to prevent erosion.

Update: Dave Poole, Public Works, received 3 quotes last week ranging from \$37,000-\$40,000 per boardwalk, Adrianna, Redington Beach Deputy Clerk, is working on grants(50/50) for State of Florida- DEP, Town of Redington Beach may consider doing one boardwalk a year with the first boardwalk at 162nd, the second at 163rd, and the third at 158th, suggested boardwalk materials: composite for the decking, wood on side rails, and top rail composite, this will be part of the Town of Redington Beach budget, in addition to the grant funding discussed above

2. Town Park

A. 5-12 Playground Equipment

Town of Redington Beach lawyer is putting together RFP, once completed, this will be presented to Park Board, Park Board reviewed priorities for the park, 1. Play surface turf, to include grading of the site for proper drainage, 2. Large play structure designed for children ages 5-12 years old, and 3. Swing structure

Additional conversation, regarding increasing the recreation in the parks to potentially include food trucks, future Town of Redington Beach galas, etc. will be discuss further at future meeting

3. Friendship Park

A. Plantings and Groundcover

Native plants difficult to find locally per Dave Poole, Public Works, Dave visited 4 local nurseries to purchase Oak Leaf Hydrangea for Friendship Park but none of quality were available, Board Member Mandy to contact/visit Wilcox Nursery to determine availability of native plants that require low shade with some flowers, will need 7-8 plants per Dave

4. Holiday Lights

Update: Contract has been completed with Lee Clark for an additional 5 years, contracting for 80 lights plus one standing, all poles in Redington Beach have been cataloged by Park Board and Commissioner Cariello, Park Board unanimously agreed to allow Lee Clark to place pole lights in the same format as the prior year on the poles that already have brackets, this decision will allow the new Park Board opportunity to re-evaluate light placement this season to make any needed changes to light placement in upcoming holiday seasons, Dave Poole, Public Works, regularly compiles list of lighting not working and gives to AJ at Duke Energy, holiday lights to be placed the week before Thanksgiving.

5. Memorial Bench at Beach Park

DEP walked beach with Mayor Will and determined 7 benches on beach was too many resulting in unnamed bench being removed and put on causeway, offered resident requesting Beach Park bench an option to purchase a bench and place on shell area of Beach Park or at Moon Park, Chairperson Tiffany to address resident, will await resident decision, Commissioner Cariello suggested offering memorial space on last 10-15 feet of mural wall at Beach Park or wall at Moon Park with a standardized plaque for future memorial requests, Chairperson Tiffany suggested future discussion on a process for maintenance of benches and future memorials, discussion regarding company in Largo that makes plaques for Town of Redington Beach

New Business

1. Town Park sand toy replacement

Park Board to discuss with donor family possible replacement options for sand toy as sand toy is deteriorating due to age and weather and is becoming a hazard, rock and plaque to remain in place, Board Member Fran to contact family

2. Moon Park shower replacement

Dave Poole, Public Works, suggested to Park Board replacement of shower in Moon Park to replicate the shower located at Beach Park, estimated cost of \$1100-1200, will discuss financial status with Commission and Mayor Will, to discuss at next Park Board meeting

3. Sign at Town Park entrance

Signage needed at Town Park, Park Board needs a vendor to duplicate style of signs in Redington Beach, Dave Poole, Public Works, to discuss with Missy, Town Clerk, regarding vendor, price, and size, to discuss at next Park Board meeting

4. Redington Beach turtle lights signage

Commissioner Cariello suggested two small signs along Gulf Blvd, near entry of town, noting the 'turtle friendly' status of Redington Beach, these signs could be added onto current sign, funded by city budget, topic can be added to unfinished business next meeting

5. Dog waste containers/ signage to curb dog/dog waste bags

Commissioner Cariello suggested placing dog waste containers throughout green spaces within Town of Redington Beach, these could be in the same style as the current ones on the causeway, plan to ask city to budget, and topic to be added to unfinished business next meeting, suggestions for enforcement of "curb your dog" to be discussed
