ORDINANCE NO. 2022-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 17 OF THE TOWN CODE (SIGNS) TO CLARIFY PROHIBITIONS ON VEHICLE SIGNS; MAKING RELATED FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY, AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town adopted its current sign code on February 17th 2021 via Ordinance 2019-07; and

WHEREAS, the Town's current sign code does not sufficiently express the intent of the Town's Board of Commissioners with respect to the display of vehicle signs within the Town and so has asked the Town Attorney to revise the relevant sections of the Code to ensure the prohibition is more clearly stated; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the interest of the public health, safety, welfare, and community aesthetic to prohibit vehicle signs within the Town in the manner set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Redington Beach, Florida, that:

Section 1. the definition of Vehicle Sign in § 17-1 of the Redington Beach Town Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 17-1. – Definitions.

Vehicle sign means a sign which covers more than one and one half~~ten~~ square feet of the vehicle, which identifies a business, products, or services, and which is attached to, mounted, pasted, painted, or drawn on a motorized or drawn vehicle, and is parked and visible from the public right-of-way; ~~unless said vehicle is used for transporting people or materials in the normal day-to-day operation of the business.~~

Section 2. Section 17-4(32) of the Redington Beach Town Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 17-4 – Prohibited signs.

- (32) Vehicle signs visible from a street or right-of-way between sundown and sunrise~~within 100 feet of the vehicle and where the vehicle is parked for more than two consecutive hours in any 24 hour period within 100 feet of said street or right-of-way.~~

Section 3. For purposes of codification of any existing section of the Redington Beach Code herein amended, words underlined represent additions to original text, words ~~stricken~~ are deletions from the original text, and words neither underlined nor stricken remain unchanged.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, provision or word of this Ordinance is held unconstitutional or otherwise legally invalid, same shall be severable and the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity, such that any remainder of the Ordinance shall withstand any severed provision, as the Board of Commissioners would have adopted the Ordinance and its regulatory scheme even absent the invalid part.

Section 5. The Codifier shall codify the substantive amendments to the Redington Beach Town Code contained in Sections 1 and 2 of this Ordinance as provided for therein, and shall not codify the exordial clauses nor any other sections not designated for codification.

Section 6. Pursuant to Florida Statutes § 166.041(4), this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA,
AMENDING § 15-28 OF THE TOWN CODE TO CLARIFY ELIGIBILITY
FOR SERVICE ON THE TOWN PLANNING BOARD; MAKING
RELATED FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION,
SEVERABILITY, AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, § 15-28 provides for the composition, terms and membership eligibility for the Town's Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, § 15-28 currently provides that Planning Board members shall be "residents" of the Town; and

WHEREAS, this language is inconsistent with provisions in the Town's charter (as to Commissioners), and the Town's Code (as to Parks Board and Board of Adjustment), all of which require office holders to be "qualified electors" of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Attorney has recommended that § 15-28 be revised so as to bring its membership requirement in line with these other provisions of Town Code to ensure consistency and to avoid any question regarding eligibility for future applicants; and

WHEREAS, the Town Attorney has also recommended that § 15-28 be clarified to confirm that no employee or officer of the Town shall be eligible to be appointed to the Planning Board, and that the section be made gender-neutral when referencing the Planning Board's presiding officer; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the interest of the Town to adopt this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Redington Beach, Florida, that:

Section 1. Section 15-28 of the Redington Beach Town Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 15-28. - Membership; term of office; officers.

The planning board shall be composed of the following number of members with the following qualifications, and shall operate in the following manner:

- (1) The planning board shall consist of five members and two alternate, who shall be appointed by the board of commissioners.
- (2) The members of the planning board shall be qualified electors ~~residents~~ of the town.

- (3) ~~Not more than one~~ member of the planning board shall be an elected or appointed officer of the town or an employee of the town, ~~or hold any other position with the town.~~
- (4) Members of the planning board shall be appointed for overlapping terms of five years each, and each appointment shall run from the time of appointment until such appointee's successor is duly qualified.
- (5) Members of the planning board shall serve without compensation except as otherwise may be provided by ordinance or resolution of the commission from time to time.
- (6) The planning board shall elect annually, at the time of its first meeting, a chairman, vice-chairman and secretary from among its members.

Section 2. For purposes of codification of any existing section of the Redington Beach Code herein amended, words underlined represent additions to original text, words ~~stricken~~ are deletions from the original text, and words neither underlined nor stricken remain unchanged.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, provision or word of this Ordinance is held unconstitutional or otherwise legally invalid, same shall be severable and the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity, such that any remainder of the Ordinance shall withstand any severed provision, as the Board of Commissioners would have adopted the Ordinance and its regulatory scheme even absent the invalid part.

Section 4. The Codifier shall codify the substantive amendments to the Redington Beach Town Code contained in Section 1 of this Ordinance as provided for therein, and shall not codify the exordial clauses nor any other sections not designated for codification.

Section 5. Pursuant to Florida Statutes § 166.041(4), this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
