2. Friendship Park

A. Plantings and Groundcover

Board member Mandy Kwon presented information to Board obtained from Wilcox Nursery regarding potential Florida native plants for Friendship Park plantings, Bahama Cassia and the Florida privet were recommended and discussed, Board unanimously decided to use the Bahama Cassia, Dave Poole, Public Works to obtain 7-8 plants from Wilcox Nursery and plant in Friendship Park

3. Beach Park

Redington Beach family wishing to donate bench to Beach Park sand area has decided not to pursue this option and Board updated, Board updated that picnic table/bench donation is pending at Moon Park

2. Town Events

Park Board, and Commissioner Cariello, suggested coordinating with Redington Beach organizations: Santas Angels, RBPOA, and Garden Club, for future events. Garden Club representative would like to promote flocking. Fran Massucci volunteered to be the liaison between the Park Board and the Redington Beach community organizations and will reach out to each.

Redington Beach resident asked Park Board to consider Pickleball Court at a future date. Park Board acknowledged they would like to promote multigenerational use of the community parks and agreed to further discuss at a future meeting.

4. Friendship Park decking

Dave Poole asked the Board to consider a suggestion from Mayor Will to contract out a deck along the dirt hill under the Oak trees in Friendship Park, Board in unanimous agreement for Mayor Will to proceed to propose decking suggestion to the Board of Commissioners
