**Call To Order**

**Approval of Regular Meeting Minutes of April 4, 2022** passed unanimously to reflect a corrected date of April 4, 2022.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

**Storage:**

- Commissioner Cariello – checked with Dave Poole in Public Works on storing items that Member Goldstein has for catering. Reports that there is quite a bit of room to store items. Suggests we store items downstairs.
- Chairperson Terracciano to talk to RBPOA (Lisa Miller) to use space underneath stairs.
- Member Goldstein to provide list of items to Chairperson Terracciano so she can gauge size.

**Budget Items**

Board to develop budget for the following and present to Commission. Give Numbers to Town Clerk by June meeting

- Mardi Gras Event – Town Clerk had number for this.
- Town Birthday Party
  - Mid June, 2023
  - Old fashion games
  - Member Goldstein: Picnic style. Hamburgers, pie contest, Member Goldstein to come up with cost for food/grill
  - 600 ppl
  - Chairperson Terracciano – kids games, decorations
  - Hire a truck for beer/wine purchase
  - Need permission from fire chief to block off road.
- Playground Reveal –include with town BD party.
- Holiday Lights - already approved.
- Christmas party (dec 10) – Comm Cariello has a fire truck for 90 minutes to donate and will book for Dec 10.

**Beer/Wine sale for parties.** Suggestion from resident Roger Kramer to have a food truck sell it. Example: 3 daughters to handle.

Wine fest go to vendors and have them donate food as advertising.

Possibly have food trucks being subsidized by town. Sell tickets for food.

### **Playground Update**

- Chairperson Terracciano indicated that the vendor is 28 weeks out for supplies. Contracts are signed and things are rolling.

### **Friendship park deck**

- Member Massucci presenting deck samples waiting on quote for work.
- Member Massucci presented Quote from Waco Construction. Labor and Material total presented for 48' x 16' was \$11,520
- Waiting for other quotes.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 162<sup>nd</sup> Ave Beach Boardwalk. Deputy Clerk applied for a grant and we ranked 18<sup>th</sup> and will most likely not get money. 162<sup>nd</sup> Ave worst - \$42,000 (6 month old quote).
- An RFP will have to be put out for the boardwalk and deck.
- Still not a safety issue, but Pubic Works continually repairs.

Commissioner Cariello reported that 2 residents applied for the vacancy on the Park Board - Anastasia Perera and Mike Baker.
