Handicapped access on the beach

- Member Tamburri brought up a point that Redington Beach has no handicapped ramp at any of the beach entrances. Town Clerk Missy Clarke stated that there had been investigations in the past as to how a ramp could be installed but was deemed not possible at that time.
- Chairperson Tiffany Terracciano suggested making available beach specific wheelchairs as an alternative. Town clerk Missy Clarke stated that that idea had also been discussed previously but due to logistics, it was too complicated of a solution.
- Member Tamburri agreed to look into more possible solutions for the town to provide access to the beach for handicapped citizens.
