PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
September 12th, 2022**

APPROVAL OF REGULAR MEETING MINUTES of August 1, 2022 Motion to approve by Member Goldstein, Second by Member Tamburri. Motioned carried with all ayes.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Update to 159th Triangle Work

Sprinkler system has been installed and the county reclaimed water supply line has been scheduled.

All of year 22 funds have been spent so plants will be discussed at the next meeting so we can use year 23 funds.

2. Beach Park Spruce Up

Town Clerk Nieves explained that the Public Works Department staff cleans the shower area Mondays and Fridays. The Public Works Department reported that someone stacked shells inside shower floor area.

Park Board agreed to look at shower area and come with ideas to next meeting.

3. Dog Park

5. Beach Handicap access-Member Tamburri update?

Member Tamburri has to get some more measurements and will provide information at the next meeting in October.

6. Pickle Ball Court Continued discussion- Update?

After talking to the contractor and the increased prices due to inflation, the Parks Board decided to hold off on further discussion of adding a pickleball court to the park.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Public Safety Day-Town Clerk Nieves stated that the Town is scheduled to host a Public Safety Day on October 15th. Town Clerk Nieves asked if members of the Park Board can help with promotion of the event and also with preparations. Chairperson Terracciano will reach out to Sea Turtle group to see if they would like to attend. Humane society reach out?

2. Commissioner Cariello stated that he was approached by several residents about adding a memorial rock to the 159th triangle park for resident Wally Hawthorne who recently passed away. A few residents said they would sponsor the cost of rock and plaque. Board voted 5-0 in favor of allowing memorial rock.
