- a. Final reading ORDINANCE NO. 2022-16:**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, CREATING § 21-34 OF THE TOWN CODE TO REQUIRE CERTAIN TOWN PARKING SPACES TO BE USED FOR ONLY CERTAIN PURPOSES; MAKING RELATED FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY, AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Attorney Eschenfelder read the Ordinance by title only. A motion by Vice Mayor Kornijtschuk and seconded by Commissioner Cariello to approve Ordinance 2022-16. Commissioner Murray brought up that vehicles park at Friendship Park while conducting Town business or attending a meeting at Town Hall.

- A. Public comment:** Meredith Cameron, 16400 Gulf Blvd. Unit 311, questioned the legality of whether a city can restrict parking in publicly owned spaces. He is also concerned about enforcement. Attorney Eschenfelder confirmed that a local government can decide how public spaces are used for the good of the public. Attorney Eschenfelder also stated that Deputies can use their discretion when issuing citations. Roll call was taken and Ordinance 2022-16 passed on its final reading.
