UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Playground update -The Board approved 3 additional truckloads of stone. Chair Terracciano will check with Kristine Frost on expected delivery time of the rock, so Deputy Clerk can schedule a public works employee to be present to instruct workers on the excavation / grading of the base fill. Playground equipment installation has begun.

2. Postcards / calendar of events - Chair Terracciano, member Massucci and Mike Brown are all working on a postcard mailout that will include event dates for the year 2023 for all Boards, including Park Board, Garden Club, RBPOA and Santa's Angels. Jackie suggested Rain dates will be scheduled for the next day. The suggested size for postcard is a 6x9. Waiting on prices from postal service.

3. Mardi Gras- updates

- a. RBPOA-will donate and drop off 5 cases of water, and allow us to use 4-tables plus chairs.
- b. Chair Terracciano is compiling a list of supplies to be purchased.
Some of the items needed are 3,000 cups (200 people x 15 gumbo contestants)
table covers, spoons, napkins, food serving gloves, bottle of hand sanitizer, ticket's and

decorations.

We are still seeking gumbo & golf cart participants.

Chair Terracciano will check with Salty Sister to see if they will donate popcorn.

Member Massucci is checking with Nauchmans.

Commissioner Cariello is looking into the possibility of a fire truck to lead the golf cart parade.

c. Wheel charm award for golf cart winner was ordered on 12/30.

d. Member Massucci is looking into having Koozies donated.

e. Chair Terracciano is looking into getting a bounce house at a cost of \$230 for the day. However, if the playground is complete by Mardi-Gras, it will not be necessary.

Chair Terracciano is notifying local balloon artist's as well as face painting artist's.

Also waiting to hear back from Kona Ice.

f. It was suggested that more parade route signs be ordered. Also talked about using the old signs and adding new numbers that match the existing font.

g. Chair Terracciano and member Mike Baker has or will reached out to volunteer groups / schools for students to help and receive community credits. However, neither of them have heard back from these groups

h. Special Meeting dates-February 13th meeting 6pm.

i. Volunteer Meeting date- to be announced.

Member Goldstein made comment that we are a different Park Board and would like to make a difference in the Town. He would like to have more backing from our Commission Board.

On behalf of Commissioner Cariello, Dee gave us an update about the Christmas lights (pole outages). Commissioner Cariello had been out for 3 hours the prior evening checking the lights.
