Mardi Gras Event

- Short on participants – 9 total for gumbo, 7 for parade
- Chuck stated he has definite participants who will sign up
- RBPOA will provide 10 – 12 cases of water
- 8 volunteers are signed up for event
- Chairperson Tiffany reported that she has found a children's face painter for \$150 for the first hour, \$100 additional per hour
- Tiffany also reported that we will not move forward with kona ice at \$200 nor will we have tiki ice at \$150-\$250. Also reported that we will not move ahead with plans to have salty sisters popcorn as the cost is too high.
- Member Massucci provided an update on koozies for giveaways. On schedule to have prior to event
- Dave Poole to provide tables and garbage cans
- Chuck inquired about table cloths. Tiffany responded that there have been rolls of table coverings purchased for event.
- Tiffany will email volunteers prior to 2/13 special meeting.

- Tiffany went over golf cart parade schedule then proceeded to go over gumbo cookoff schedule.
- Commissioner Cariello inquired about time of ribbon cutting ceremony prior to gumbo event. It was decided that the new playground ribbon cutting ceremony would take place at 12:30 pm.
- Jaki to handle the 50/50 raffle. She asked what the pricing should be. It was decided that tickets will run \$5 for 6, \$7 for 10, \$1 per single ticket and \$10 for an arm's length.
- A participant in the audience asked about the parade route. Maps will be handed out during the cart lineup.

Additional items discussed (non agenda items)

A blue card for speaking was presented from Ron Graham of 15920 Redington Drive. He referenced the new beautification work being done on the corner lot park on 158th and 159th. He suggested placing a library box there. Ron's neighbor John Everett, who lives near the park, also showed interest in having a box there for residents. A motion was made by Chuck Goldstein and a 2nd by Jaki Tamburri to allow them to build and install a box in the park. All members voted yes for this.

Mr. Graham also asked if there can be a bike rack placed near Town park. The board has recycle money that can be used for such item. Jaki Tamburri made a motion to explore the cost and feasibility of acquiring the bike rack, Member Massucci with the 2nd. All members voted yes.
