REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
May 1st, 2023**

The Park Board of the Town of Redington Beach, Florida met on Monday, May 1, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. in Redington Beach Town Hall, at 105-164th Avenue, Redington Beach, Florida

1. CALL TO ORDER and PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE 6pm

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES of Regular Meeting, April 3rd, 2023 - Approval with change that I, Mike Baker was present. Fran-Motion Mike-2nd

5. Oath of Office

a. Chuck Goldstein- Postponed

6. NEW BUSINESS

a. July's golf cart parade -Tuesday July, 4. 9:30a line up and a 10a start. Someone to lead the parade. Tiffany mentioned we should purchase some throws for the parade. We discussed purchasing a bullhorn and who would pay for it?

Chuck and Fran to place the parade signs 1 week out. Tiffany will draft an email to add to the town email.

b. Turtle signs to be added to 2-Town signs on Gulf Blvd. - Fran will make a call to Anthony the artist to see if he can make a sign for us.

c. Holiday lighting – review and map out locations.

Verify the amount of pigtales we have and are being charged for. Make a plan to test the pigtales -Commissioner Cariello explained last year's problems. Check to see if Duke is charging us more than we have. (We have 80 lights and are being billed for 82). Determine where we want the holiday lights to be put. Tiffany stated that we should focus on Gulf Blvd first to make sure that looks good first then move to the side streets. Need to see if the bracket are on all the pole. If a pole has no bracket, we need to have one installed. There are 54 total lights on Gulf Blvd that have turtle lights.

The Park Board will double check the pole locations and identify where we want the angel lights by the August Meeting.

7. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

a. Sand Box - Tiffany reached out to Tree Trop Products about a double planter. Too pricey for what we are looking for. Tiffany found a nice box on Wayfair. Still looking for ideas for the sand toy box. Use Trex Boards that way we can use the recycled money (\$348.04)

b. Orchid project - Tiffany reported that they are starting May 2nd on the project and a follow up date of May 9th.

c. Plants at beach park - Bev Rowsey said flowers are already at that park.- No need for more to be planted.

d. Left over recycle money – where/how to apply it (\$348.04) Maybe purchase recycled material for dog poop bags as an option if we can't use it for the sandbox. Another option would be a recycled material trash can for Friendship Park to replace the metal can.

e. 2023 Mardi-Gras expenditures / budget report- Tiffany stated that it should come out of the Park Board budget but not out of the Mardi-Gras line item. Total for Mardi \$1333.08 + \$24.08 for a total of \$1357.16 for the event. Commissioner Cariello asked us to create a cost analysis for the event.

We will need about \$1,500-\$2,000 budgeted for next year.
