**6. NEW BUSINESS**

- a. Orchids in Friendship Park – Brett w/ Accent Orchids will attend meeting to address the board  
Brett gave a presentation about the Bay Area Orchids Project. Brett will provide drawings of park and locations of orchids for approval from the Park Board and Commissioners. Park Board will speak to the Garden Club to see if anyone would like to learn and help care for orchids. Brett should coordinate with the Town Clerk upon arrival at park to present his drawings for placement of the orchids in the park.

b. Sand Toy (Box) – Give one, Leave one

- Tiffany explained her idea of the toy box. She has a plan created and would like to add it to Beach Park. Once the box has been established with the exact location and size, it needs to be presented to the Commission for final approval. Board voted 5-0 to move forward with project.

- Overall the Board agrees it was a successful event. Tiffany put together a survey to receive feedback. She received 4 answers already. Great feedback. Some of the suggestions were not letting people vote on winners. Maybe some different prizes for 2nd and 3rd.

  - Who decides winners-Maybe a Culinary arts school can judge.
- Golf Cart Parade Responses.

  - Slower
  - Put times on a map so people know when to be in front of the house for the parade.
  - Dee suggested using chalk arrows on the road.
  - Fran suggested the judging of the carts takes place at the beginning of the parade and adding different categories for prizes.
  - Park all carts in the soccer field.
