Public Safety

Building/Code

- Commissioner Skjoldager reported that the Town has posted permitting info on the website so that permits for repairs caused by the December storm would be made a priority.

- Commissioner Cariello reported that Shenandoah Contractors has finished the valve repairs and all valves are working properly.

Town Attorney

The Town's motion was granted, the stay was lifted, and the clerk of court has been directed to schedule a pre-trial conference.
