4. APPROVAL OF AGENDA of December 4th, 2023 – Fran motioned and Mike seconded.

5. New Business:

- b) Discussed Mardi Gras preparations and meeting dates. Special meeting date will be Jan. 22nd 2023 at 6pm, followed by Feb. regular meeting on the 5th. Mardi Gras Event to be held on Feb. 17th. 6. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- a. Storage Shed-The board was presented with a couple of options and agreed on one to purchase. Motion-Fran, Second-Mike approved 3-0.
- b. Holiday golf cart parade – Date for 2024 will be Friday Dec. 6th 6-8pm.

- c. Friendship Park - decking project. Fran has been in contact with contractors but is having a hard time getting them to commit to providing an estimate. He will continue working on getting additional quotes. Town to ask Nicholes if a concrete pad is doable.
- d. Plants for Moon Park (Sea Oats recommended) The board has agreed on the choice of Sea oats. Dave / public works will plant the sea oats and also install a spicket for irrigation to help establish the new plants. Deputy Clerk to check with County for free sea-oats.
- e. Deputy Clerk to provide cost for Halloween event – Including the cost of the signs, the total cost was \$923.83

- a) Holiday lights that are out - Dave is counting tonight and will give an update on 12/5. Board to find 6 locations for remaining Angels throughout the town. Dave Poole's findings of holiday lights that are not working was given to Deputy Clerk 12/5/2023, Deputy clerk will email the park board the findings.
- b) Turtle signs- Dave explained how he thinks they should be installed and the board agreed.
