TOWN OF RICE LAKE RESIDENTS

The following items may be dropped off at the Town of Rice Lake Recycling Center, 1830 Macauley Ave., Rice Lake, during business hours (closed if falls on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Christmas Day):

PLEASE SEPARATE RECYCLABLE ITEMS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **PLASTICS: #1, #2 & #5** bottles and containers empty and rinsed with caps on. **NO BLACK OR BROWN PLASTIC**
2. **GLASS:** White, Green and Brown jars and bottles. **Caps off**, labels left on, and rinsed out **clean**.
3. **NEWSPAPER & WEEKLY ADVERTISING FLYERS (SHINEY ADS):** If it comes in a newspaper, it stays with the newspapers. Bundled together.
4. **MIXED PAPER:** all grades of paper, white, colored, carbonless, envelopes (including windowed, labeled and craft), file folders, post-it notes, junk mail, shredded paper. Bundled together.
DO NOT INCLUDE soiled or contaminated paper such as napkins, paper plates, hand towels or other paper products from rest rooms, carbon paper, cellophane or waxed paper.
5. **MAGAZINES AND CATALOGS:** Includes paper that is soft covered bound or stapled, books, glued pads or tablets, spiral notebooks. Bundled together. **NO HARD COVER BOOKS!**
6. **CARDBOARD:** Corrugated and pressed cardboard such as cereal boxes, etc. Must be broken down
7. **ALUMINUM:** Cans and scrap aluminum.
8. **TIN CANS, EMPTY AEROSOL CANS & SCRAP METAL:** Tin cans should have labels removed and rinsed clean.
9. **BATTERIES: NO LONGER TAKING BATTERIES**

ANNUAL WHITE GOODS & ELECTRONICS CLEAN-UP DAY:

White Goods including stoves, refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, microwaves, along with electronics, TV's, computers, monitors, printers, etc, are collected **ONLY** on the annual White Goods & Electronics clean-up day held in April of each year. Fees are applicable. Watch the Early Bird & town website for notice.

PLEASE DO NOT DROP ITEMS OFF AT THE RECYCLING CENTER OUTSIDE OF BUSINESS HOURS. FINES WILL BE ISSUED TO VIOLATORS.

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
