TOWN OF RICHMOND AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT OF "NO-PARKING" ZONES WITHIN THE TOWN OF RICHMOND

The Town Board of the Town of Richmond, St. Croix County, Wisconsin, hereby ordains as follows.

SECTION I. NO PARKING. The Town Board of the Town of Richmond has and will continue to establish no-parking zones when safety and other concerns warrant such action. Any such zones, once established by ordinance, shall be marked with appropriate signage, curb or street marking or both.

SECTION II. ENFORCEMENT. Vehicles parked in violation of any no-parking zone so established within the Town may be issued a citation for such violation and upon conviction, shall be assessed a fine as specified in Town Ordinance 2017-2. In the alternative, the enforcing law enforcement officer, at his/her discretion when safety or other concerns warrant, may order the offending vehicle to be towed. The owner of the vehicle shall be responsible for all charges incurred by the towing company, including, without limitation, removal fees, mileage, and storage fees. Any such fees and charges shall be paid by the owner of the towed vehicle to the towing company prior to obtaining possession of the vehicle.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY. Should any section of provisions of this Ordinance be declared invalid for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication or posting as provided by law, pursuant to Sec. 60.80 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
