BLACKTOPPING

Now accepting sealed bids for two blacktopping jobs. Submit bids as price per ton, including all watering, fine grading, flagging, etc. Work to be completed by August 15th.

- approximately 4,224 feet (~.8 mile) of Horseshoe Lake Road west from intersection with CTH W, consisting of 2½-inch compacted depth x 22-foot width E-1 hot mix asphalt.
- approximately 3,696 feet ($^{\sim}$.70 mile) of Chain Lake Road (within Town of Rusk boundaries) AND the 300 feet ($^{\sim}$.06 mile) of Park Court (from Park Drive to terminus), consisting of 1-inch compacted depth x 22-foot width asphalt overlay.

CHIP-SEALING

Now accepting bids for single chip-sealing jobs, using CRS-2 oil and 5/16 inch 100% fractured aggregate over the existing roadbed, with customary signage, flagging, etc. Work to be completed by August 15th.

- approximately 8,132 feet (~1.54 mile) of Buck Lake Road between Sugar Lake Road and CTH W (past the Rusk Town Shed) AND the 950 feet (~.18) mile of Old W, between Buck Lake Rd. and CTH W.
- approximately 4,488 feet (~.85 mile) of Park Drive (adjacent to Chain Lake Road), its entire length.

SHOULDERING

Now accepting proposals for two shouldering jobs. Submit proposal(s) as price per yard. Work to be provided will consist of installing 3-foot shoulders using ¾-inch gravel and compacting, grading, and clearing loose gravel, with customary signage, flagging, etc.

- approximately 4,224 feet (~.8 mile) of Horseshoe Lake Road west from intersection with CTH W.
- approximately 3,696 feet (~.70 mile) of Chain Lake Road, within Town of Rusk boundaries.

Bids/proposals must be received on or before 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 9, 2019, and will be opened at the monthly Board meeting on that date.

A certificate of insurance is required. Note that the Class B Highway restriction on Horseshoe Lake Road will be waived for that project.

The Town reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids/proposals, waive any informalities in the bidding process, and to accept the bids/proposals deemed most advantageous to the Town.
