Ordinance to Designate Class "B" Highway(s) — #2016-02

STATE OF WISCONSIN, Town of Rusk, Rusk County

The Town Board of the Town of Rusk, Rusk County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under §349.15 Wisc. Statutes, to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates as follows:

- A. That segment of Horseshoe Lake Road between County Line Road (on the west) and County Hwy. W (on the east) in the Town of Rusk is designated a Class "B" highway, subject to the weight limits set forth in §348.16 (2), Wisc. Statutes. Any and all exceptions require prior approval by the Town Board.
- B. The town chairman, or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on and approaching the above-described highway.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highway in violation of the weight limits set forth in §348.16 (2), Wisc. Statutes. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under §348.21, Wisc. Statutes. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.

This ordinance is effective upon placement of the appropriate signage. The town clerk will properly post or publish this ordinance as required under §60.80 Wisc. Statutes.
