Badger Books are ready for election day



Last year the Town introduced a new voting system using electronic poll books, called *Badger Books*. It improved efficiencies and minimized wait times.

Badger Books is an electronic version of the paper poll book and as such, performs only those functions. It is used to check in voters, process Election Day Registrations, and record absentee ballots.

ELECTION DAY

Prior to Election Day, the poll book for the Town is loaded into Badger Book. It completes 3 primary tasks:

- ✓ It checks in voters
- ✓ Provides Election Day Registration.
- ✓ Processes absentee ballots

After Election Day, a data file generated from BadgerBooks is used to upload election participation and Election Day Registration information into WisVote so voters may see their participation more quickly in MyVote.

How does Badger Books work?

- ~ It allows for quicker voter check-ins and registrations.
- ~ Process absentees in a snap.
- ~ Improves polling place flow.
- ~ Improves data quality.
- ~ Streamline post-election data entry and reconciliation
- ~ Voters will be able to view their participation sooner in MyVote.

ELECTRONIC BILL PAY

<u>Reminder</u>: The Scott Municipal Utility (SMU) offers the option of making utility payments via Automatic Payment. *Interested*?

Contact the Town Hall for an authorization form or go to the website: <u>www.townofscott.com</u> Under the tab *'Services'* drop down and find Bill Pay.

With automatic payments the utility bill payments will be taken directly out of a checking or savings account on approximately the 25th day of each quarter (January, April, July and October).

The Town and SMU is also set up for receiving payments via credit/debit card (*with a service fee of 2.95%*), which is also located under the "Bill Pay" tab. Further instructions are available on the website.

DOG OWNERS

The Town has received numerous complaints about dog owners not picking up after their pets. If you are a dog owner it is your responsibility to pick-up after them. If enforcement becomes necessary, citations begin at \$187.

YARD WASTE SITE

The Town's Yard Waste Site is located at the end of Bertrand Lane, west of CTH T. The site is open:

April 3 st - Nov 20 th				
Wednesday:	3:00 pm – 7:00 pm .			
Saturday:	10:00 am – 3:00 pm.			
Sunday:	10:00 am – 3:00 pm.			

The Yard Waste Site accepts grass, brush, leaves, & garden waste only. It does not accept stumps and large debris. The Town does not provide curbside collection for any of these items, we ask all residents to make their own provisions for properly disposing of these items. Finnel Landscape is contracted to manage yard waste materials at the site. Wood chips can be picked up when available, during regular hours.

<u>NO DUMPING IN THE DITCHES</u> <u>– PLEASE -</u>

The Town Board has become aware of the fact that yard waste is being dumped in road ditches and town road right-of-ways. This is illegal, as it is an infringement on Town of Scott property. The disposal of yard waste creates a series of problems; it impairs drainage, creates an unsightly atmosphere, it can become a host site for rodents, and deteriorating waste can create a very unpleasant odor. The Town policy is to administer fines to those who use the right-of-way as a

disposal site of any materials. If you are in violation please discontinue this practice immediately. The yard waste site is the place for your ward waste.

Dog License Application – Town of Scott

Dog licenses expire on December 31 of each year as indicated on the license – avoid added cost to dog licenses by renewing them when they expire at the end of the year. It is the requirement of owners to license all dogs (WI Stat 174). All dogs must have current rabies shots. If your dog is currently licensed in the Town and the rabies shot has not expired within the past year the Town will have a copy on file – there is no need to send the certification.

If your dog is no longer a part of your family please sign the back of your license and state the reason. Return to the Town of Scott Town Hall so that your dog can be removed from the Town records.
