STATE OF WISCONSIN TOWN OF SIOUX CREEK BARRON COUNTY, WISCONSIN ORDINANCE 2014-2

To Create a Five-Member Town Board

Whereas, the Town of Sioux Creek, Barron County, Wisconsin, has been authorized by the town electors to exercise village powers pursuant to WI \S 60.10(2)(c) and 60.22(3); and

Whereas, WI $\S60.21(1)$, authorizes town boards with village powers to establish a five-member town board; and

Whereas, the Town Board has determined that a five-person town board would provide greater representation to the residents of the Town of Sioux Creek;

The Town Board, pursuant to WI §60.21(1), by this ordinance adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, elects and ordains to increase the number of town supervisors for the Town of Sioux Creek to five members and further ordains that the five-member town board for the Town of Sioux Creek shall be created as follows:

For the spring election in April 2015 there will be a chair and four supervisors elected. The two supervisors receiving the greatest number of votes shall be elected for two-year terms. The two supervisors receiving the next highest number of votes shall be elected for one-year terms. Each year thereafter, two supervisors will be elected for two-year terms at each spring election, creating staggered terms pursuant to WI §60.21(1).

This ordinance shall be effective upon publication or posting by the town clerk as required, pursuant to WI §60.80.
