

**Town of Spider Lake  
Sawyer County, Wisconsin  
Ordinance No. 2013-04  
Provisional Liquor Licenses**

**Section 1. Title and Purpose**

The title of this Ordinance is the “Town of Spider Lake Provisional Liquor Licenses Ordinance”. The purpose of this ordinance is to set standards under which a provisional license may be issued for a Class “A”, Class “B”, “Class A”, “Class B”, “Class C” retail license or an operator’s license.

**Section 2. Authority**

The Town Board of the Town of Spider Lake, Sawyer County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under §125.185 & §125.17(5) Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

**Section 3. Adoption of Ordinance**

The Town Board of the Town of Spider Lake, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice, with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the Town Board present and voting, designates to the Town Clerk the authority to issue provisional retail licenses for Class “A”, Class “B”, “Class A”, “Class B”, “Class C” liquor licenses and operator’s licenses.

**Section 4. Provisions**

- A. A provisional retail license may be issued only to a person, Corporation or Partnership who has applied for a Class “A”, Class “B”, “Class A”, “Class B”, “Class C” license and authorizes only the activities that the type of retail license applied for authorizes.
- B. A provisional operator’s license may be issued only to a person.
- C. A provisional retail license expires 60 days after its issuance or when the Class “A”, Class “B”, “Class A”, “Class B”, “Class C” license is issued to the holder, whichever is sooner.
- D. A provisional operator’s license expires 60 days after its issuance or when an operator’s license is issued, whichever is sooner.
- E. The Clerk may revoke any provisional license if the Clerk discovers that the holder of the license made a false statement on the application.
- F. Notwithstanding sub.(1) under §125.185, the Clerk may not issue a provisional “Class B” license if the municipality’s quota under §125.51(4) prohibits the municipality from issuing a “Class B” license.
- G. No person, Corporation, Limited Liability Company or Partnership may hold more than one provisional retail license for each type of license applied for by holder per year.

**Section 5. Fees**

The fee for a provisional license is \$15.00 and will not be refunded for any reason.

**Section 6. Severability**

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision of application, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

**Section 7. Amendments**

Any future amendments, revisions, or modifications of Wisconsin Statutes §125.185 or §125.17(5) or any other statutes referred to in this ordinance are intended to be made part of this ordinance as such amendments, revisions, or modifications are made to said statutes.

**Section 8. Effective Date**

This Ordinance is effective upon publication or posting. The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under §60.80 Wis. Stats.
