* Chairman's Report Orfordville Fire/EMS. received an incentive grant which resulted in Brodhead not getting one for their grant for study. Consulting firms are now booked up. Several consulting firms have been interviewed to do the work in Orfordville. The Incentive grant is to look at better ways to operate the departments.

* Other Reports Rock County officer reported little activity in the town last month.

Old Business

DPW/roads Thursday morning at 9 am supervisors will meet at DPW to plan for road repairs. Some work on Dorner is needed. Avon Townline repairs will be paid to Avon after its done. Estimate is about \$28,000. Bernstein from Speich to south of Berg. needs work. Work on Dickey and possibly Gempler. will be considered. Potter Rd. Bridge currently has railroad tie mats on it to allow the school bus, propane truck and farm equipment to cross.. Three residents live beyond the bridge. Cost estimates range from \$10,000 to \$200,000 depending on what the state requires.

Ordinance ideas for ATVs Allow operation during set times(day light hours), seasonal time frame to avoid snow and ice, insurance should be same as an automobile, anyone under 18 needs to wear a helmet and use seatbelt. Children under 4 not allowed and weight and height restrictions to ride should apply like in cars. Contact lawyer about what risks there are to the town. Have Mark draft an ordinance. Enforcement problem could occur . Town needs some standard rules. There will need to be a public meeting to accept the ordinance.
