

## Oneida County Emergency Management Free NOAA Weather Radio Program



Oneida County Emergency Management is sponsoring a NOAA Weather Radio Program. NOAA Weather radios are a quick and efficient way to pass emergency messages to the public through the National Weather Service. The radios are primarily used as an alert notification warning system for weather events like tornadoes, severe thunderstorms etc...

The radios are free, distribution will be on a first-come, first serve basis under the following criteria:

- Public / Private School located in Oneida County
- Functional Needs Facility located in Oneida County
- Mobile home residents located in Oneida County
- Oneida County residents living in a rural area not covered by an outdoor warning siren
  - Oneida County residents that cannot afford a NOAA Weather Radio

To apply for a free NOAA Weather Radio fill out the application and bring to the Oneida County Emergency Management Department located at 2000 East Winnebago Street, Rhinelander or any participating Municipal Fire Departments or Town Offices.
