## Wisconsin Towns Association 2015 Scholarship Program

For the 30<sup>th</sup> year, Wisconsin Towns Association, in conjunction with Rural Mutual Insurance Company, carrier for the Association's endorsed insurance program, and Scott Construction, Inc. will be awarding \$7,000.00 in scholarships to the winners of an essay contest to high school seniors graduating in 2015 from either a public or private high school in Wisconsin, who plan to enroll in a Wisconsin public or private college or vocational college. The winners are determined by independent judging of an essay contest. The essay should address the topic: "Why is town road investment important to economic development in Wisconsin?"

Wisconsin Town's Association is a non-profit association of towns and village officials promoting education for local government officials throughout the state. These activities include workshops, printed memos, and working with the University of Wisconsin Extension on WISLINE programs presented at various sites on the WISINE system.

All students graduating from a Wisconsin high school in 2015 and planning to attend a Wisconsin public or private college or vocational college are eligible to submit an essay on the above topic. Home school students are eligible if receiving a high school diploma in 2015. Students do not need to be residents of towns. We welcome residents of villages and cities to submit essays. The submission deadline requires the essay to be received or postmarked by May 30, 2015. Please keep your name and address out of the actual essay, and submit on the Background Information Cover Sheet.
