Winter Hours: January 6, 2024 thru May 27, 2024

Open: Sat/Mon	8:00 am – 12:00 noon
Sun	9:00 am – 12:00 noon

Summer Hours: June 1, 2024 thru September 30, 2024

Open: Sat/Sun/Mon 8:00 am – 1:00 pm; 1:30 pm – 4:00 pm *(Site will close for 30 minute lunch break)*
Wednesday 8:00 am – noon

Fall Hours: October 5, 2024 thru December 30, 2024

Open: Sat/Mon	8:00 am – 12:00 noon
Sun	9:00 am – 12:00 noon

Brush Site Information: *Open seasonally (typically Memorial Day – Thanksgiving) the same hours as the transfer station*

Brush not larger than 6" in diameter: \$25.00 per standard pickup or standard trailer (up to 4 cubic yards)
\$50.00 per standard pickup & trailer (8 cubic yards)
\$100.00 per standard dump truck (16 cubic yards)

Leaves & Grass: \$10.00 per standard pickup or standard trailer (up to 4 cubic yards)
\$20.00 per standard pickup & trailer (8 cubic yards)
\$50.00 per standard dump truck (16 cubic yards)

Yard & Garden Waste in bags: \$1.00/bag

Items accepted include:

Garbage: one single bag (**max 30 lbs per bag**) = **\$3.15 coupon or \$4.00 cash**
Other Items: Furniture, Tires, Appliances, Metal = see backside of this flyer
Trash bags over 30 lbs. are minimum of \$5.00 or at the attendant's discretion.

Recyclables are accepted free of charge - you can co-mingle these items:

Flattened cardboard/boxes	Envelopes & junk mail
Newspapers	Aluminum & steel cans
Magazines	Clean aluminum foil
Office papers	All plastic bottles/containers marked #1, #2, #5
Glass bottles/jars	Milk/Water/Juice bottles

*The Three Lakes Transfer Site does not accept any hazardous waste such as old gas, oil, or oil-based paint cans. Those items must be taken to the Oneida County Solid Waste Department landfill at 7450 County Highway K in Rhinelander.
