SEX OFFENDER RELEASE - COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION



The Wisconsin Department of Department Corrections probation and parole has informed the Three Lakes Police Department that a registered sex offender David Michael Teresinski will be released under extended supervision and will reside at his address at 1816 Timbershore Drive in the Town of Three Lakes in Oneida County Wisconsin on September 30, 2025.

The Three Lakes Police Department is not responsible for release but responsible for community notification. The Three Lakes Police Department is releasing this information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 and 301.46 (Act 449 and Act 5). This does authorize law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offenders release when, in the discretion of the agency, the release of the information will enhance public safety and protection.

On July 28, 2020, he was convicted of 3rd Degree Sexual Assault and sentenced to 10yrs Wisconsin State Prison system, comprised of 5yrs initial confinement and 5yrs of extended supervision. Teresinski 5yrs of extended supervision will begin on September 30, 2025. Another case of Exposing Genitals or Pubic Area and Repeated Sexual Assault of a child was dismissed but read in at sentencing (Oneida County case 17CF305).

Teresinski targeted victims were juvenile females from the ages of eight to ten years old and children of female partners.

Upon release he is required to be on the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry until October 2, 2045, and is not required to be on GPS monitoring.

Teresinski's rules will restrict him from contact with anyone under the age of 18 unless accompanied by an agent approved chaperone. He will not be allowed at parks, daycares, schools, or any place frequented by minor children unless pre-approved. He will be allowed internet but will NOT be allowed social media or access to pornographic material.

Citizen's abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated.

The Three Lakes Police Department will be making door to door notifications within ½ mile of this residence.
