



## EMERGENCY WEIGHT LIMIT EXEMPTION APPLICATION

Sec. 70-144. Exceptions.

Pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 349.16, certain vehicles other than school bus, town vehicles and emergency vehicles may be exempted from the limitations and restrictions of this Division on an as-needed basis at the discretion of the Public Works Superintendent after review of a duly-filed Exemption Application and following consultation with the Chief of Police with respect to any issues that may affect the public health, safety and welfare.
