February is American Heart Month. Cardiovascular disease is the leading cause of death in the United States; one in every three deaths is from heart disease and stroke, equal to 2,200 deaths per day. One-third of all heart attacks occur with no prior warning signs. In the remainder, attacks of chest pain (angina) brought about by stress or exertion occurs periodically for months or years prior to a heart attack. In some cases, a mild heart attack produces no symptoms and is often referred to as a "silent heart attack." Here are a few of the warning signs you should know:

- Chest pain or pressure, tightness, squeezing, burning, aching, or heaviness in the chest lasting longer than 10 minutes. The pain or discomfort is usually located in the center of the chest just under the breastbone and may radiate down the arm (especially the left), up into the neck, or along the jaw line.
- Shortness of breath.
- Profuse sweating.
- Dizziness.
- Muscle weakness.
- Nausea and vomiting.
- A choking sensation.



Anxiety or a feeling of impending doom.

So remember that half of folks who have heart attacks will not have classic symptoms like you see in the movies. This is especially confusing for women because many people mistakenly believe that men have heart attacks at a higher rate (in fact the numbers are nearly identical).

Prevention starts with everyone. Protect yourself and your loved ones from heart disease and stroke by understanding the risks and taking these steps.

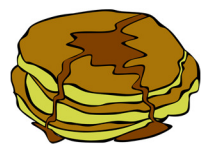
Get up and get active by being physically active for at least 30 minutes on most days of the week. Know your ABCS:

- Ask your doctor if you should take an Aspirin every day.
- Find out if you have high Blood pressure or Cholesterol, and if you do, get effective treatment.
- If you Smoke, get help to quit.
- Make your calories count by eating a heart-healthy diet high in fresh fruits and vegetables and low

in sodium and trans fat.
