The race traditionally runs the 1st Saturday in May at the Churchill Downs race track. On May 5th, 2017 at approximately 5pm, 20 thoroughbreds will take their place at the gate for a chance to run the 1 ¼ mile track, cross the finish line and ultimately be the recipient of the famous rose covered blanket.
