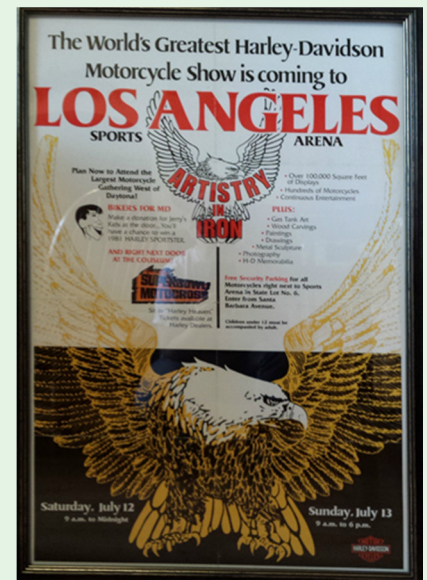


PICKETT LIONS
