#### Microwave coffee cup scramble

Prep Time: 1 minute

Cook Time: 45-60 seconds

Makes: 1 serving

What you need: 2 eggs, 2 Tbsp milk, 2 Tbsp shredded cheddar cheese, salt & pepper.

#### Here's how:

1. Coat 12-oz microwave-safe coffee mug with cooking spray. ADD eggs and milk; beat until blended.

2. Microwave on high 45 seconds; stir

Microwave until eggs are almost set, 30 to 40 seconds longer.

3. Top with cheese; season with salt and pepper
