C) Single-stream containers coming soon! The Town Board approved a new contract with Advanced Disposal to move to singlestream recycling to help cut cost. You will get a new container to put your recycling in. We will still use the same garbage container. The green rectangle bins we use now will not be used when the new container are delivered, so you can do as you please with those rectangle bins. It will take some time to order the bins and have them delivered so continue to do as you currently are until you get the new container. Recycling will then be picked up every-other week. We will share the recycling calendar when we are given one to help you know the weeks to put the recycling bins at the end of your driveway.



Do you have a Power of Attorney for Healthcare? This is the preferred legal form in Wisconsin. On this form you appoint someone you trust to make medical choices for you when you are unable to do so. Wisconsin also honors 5 Wishes forms. A Living Will only tells end-of-life choices.

Who is good at making decisions and can be strong when needed? What is important to you for your healthcare? Do you have any religious concerns?
