At an election to be held in the Town of Utica in Winnebago County, Wisconsin on Tuesday, April 2, 2024, the following proposed Ordinance of the Town Board, will be submitted to a vote of the people:

TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TOWN CLERK BY THE TOWN BOARD

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Utica desires to change the procedure for filling the Town Clerk position from the Town Clerk being an Elected position to an Appointed position.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF UTICA, WINNEBAGO COUNTY, WISCONSIN, THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to the authority granted by Section 60.30 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town Board does hereby provide for the appointment of the Town Clerk by a majority of the members-elect of the Town Board.
- 2. This Ordinance shall take effect, if approved in a referendum called by the Town Board, at the next Spring Election or General Election, provided that it shall be held no sooner than 70 days after passage of this Ordinance.
- 3. The referendum question shall be: "Shall the person holding the office of Town Clerk in the Town of Utica be appointed by the Town Board?"
- 4. If the referendum results are for the appointment of the Town Clerk, the Town Board shall appoint a Town Clerk at the end of the expiration of the current term of the Town Clerk.
- 5. A person appointed to the office of Town Clerk shall serve for a term, not to exceed three years, as set by the Town Board.
- 6. A person appointed as Town Clerk may be reappointed and may be dismissed by the Town Board, only for cause, as defined in section 17.001 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

Shall the person holding the office of Town Clerk in the Town of Utica be appointed by the Town Board?

A 'Yes' vote will mean that the current, and future, Town Clerk position shall be appointed by the Town Board and not an elected position.

A 'No' vote will mean that the current, and future, Town Clerk position shall remain an elected position.

At an election to be held in the Town of Utica in Winnebago County, Wisconsin on April 2, 2024, the following proposed Ordinance of the Town Board, will be submitted to a vote of the people:

TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TOWN TREASURER BY THE TOWN BOARD

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Utica desires to change the procedure for filling the Town Treasurer position from the Town Treasurer being an Elected position to an Appointed position.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF UTICA, WINNEBAGO COUNTY, WISCONSIN, THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to the authority granted by Section 60.30 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town Board does hereby provide for the appointment of the Town Treasurer by a majority of the members-elect of the Town Board.
- 2. This Ordinance shall take effect, if approved in a referendum called by the Town Board, at the next Spring Election or General Election, provided that it shall be held no sooner than 70 days after passage of this Ordinance.
- 3. The referendum question shall be: "Shall the person holding the office of Town Treasurer in the Town of Utica be appointed by the Town Board?"
- 4. If the referendum results are for the appointment of the Town Treasurer, the Town Board shall appoint a Town Treasurer at the end of the expiration of the current term of the Town Treasurer.
- 5. A person appointed to the office of Town Treasurer shall serve for a term, not to exceed three years, as set by the Town Board.
- 6. A person appointed as Town Treasurer may be reappointed and may be dismissed by the Town Board, only for cause, as defined in section 17.001 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

Shall the person holding the office of Town Treasurer in the Town of Utica be appointed by the Town Board?

A 'Yes' vote will mean that the current, and future, Town Treasurer position shall be appointed by the Town Board and not an elected position.

A 'No' vote will mean that the current, and future, Town Treasurer position shall remain an elected position.
