RECYCLING & GARBAGE COLLECTION – Garbage is picked up at the curbside weekly on Wednesday at each residence. Single-stream recycling is picked up every other week. There is one exception; any week that has a holiday on or before Wednesday, the garbage will be collected on Thursday of that week. A calendar of the recycling dates is available on the Town website (townofuticawi.gov) or by contacting the Clerk. Contact GFL at 1-920-685-0771 if replacement garbage/recycling bins are needed. All electronics (computers, printers, fax machines, TV's, DVD players, VCR's, etc.) must be recycled at a registered E-Cycle collector. BUILDING PERMITS – Contact Tom Thiel, Zoning Administrator, at 920-589-3005 to make sure your project meets all zoning ordinance requirements. The Town's Zoning Ordinance is on the Town website for your review.

RAZING PERMITS – Contact Tom Thiel, Zoning Administrator, at 920-589-3005 to obtain a permit; it is **FREE** and is required.

WISCONSIN INCOME TAX – Please note "Town of Utica" as your place of residence on State Income Tax forms so our Town receives its share of state aid.

WISCONSIN VEHICLE REGISTRATION – When applying for a license or registration for your automobile or truck, please be sure to show the "**TOWN OF UTICA**" as your tax district.

The Utica Volunteer Fire Department responded to a total of 55 emergencies in 2023. These included structure fires, grass fires, vehicle crashes, carbon monoxide calls, and MABAS (Mutual Aid Box Alarm System) calls.

The department recruited 3 new firefighters: Jason Bauer, Travis Banks and Kelsie Smith.

The Fire Department is always looking for Utica residents, or those in close proximity, who are interested in firefighting and helping your neighbors when disaster strikes. We always welcome DEDICATED individuals, male or female, who want to help out. Feel free to come on down to the station and see what the requirements are to join. Applications are available from any current fire department member or stop at Station 12 on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 6:30pm, 1730 County Road FF in Fisk.

Please remember to call the Winnebago County Communications Center at 920-236-7300 if you plan on burning large acreages of grass, old building materials, or brush piles. The Dispatchers will put it on their Burn Board and call your phone to see if the fire department is actually needed when people call it in as a fire.

Also, you can look up the Town's Burn Ordinance at townofuticawi.gov for what can and cannot be legally burned.

In 2023, the Utica First Responders were dispatched to 136 calls and 75 were assisting as Mutual Aid. We provide EMR coverage for 103 square miles. We respond to all emergency and non-emergency medical calls that we are called to. No matter how insignificant one may think an issue is, do not hesitate to call us. Night or day, we never mind being called, that is why we volunteer! We also provide lift assists when requested.

We have a few new members who have recently finished the training to become Emergency Medical Responders. Training to become a First Responder is 76 hours of CPR and AED spread over 6 months and taught by FVTC. Classes are taught at the Public Safety Training Center next to the Appleton Airport or at one of the fire stations in the region. Every 3 years, we need to renew our license and complete hours of training. We spread the training over the 3 years to stay more up-to-date. Training requirements are taught through FVTC. The training may seem overwhelming at first, but it is extremely rewarding to know that you really can handle any situation until an ambulance arrives. We are not just doing "basic first aid" by putting on band-aids. We have a large variety of Basic Life Support skills and equipment that enable us to confidently and effectively handle even the worst situations. If anything from holding a patient's hand while treating them for having trouble breathing, to bringing a patient back from cardiac arrest and someday getting a great big hug from them interests you, then PLEASE ask one of us about becoming a member of this life saving organization. Our First Responders are not required to be Firefighters nor are Firefighters required to be First Responders. However, cross-training is encouraged. Meetings are on the first Tuesday evening of every month. December 23, 2020 we began to provide Emergency Medical Responder coverage to the entire Town of Nepeuskun. Ripon Guardian is the Ambulance that covers Nepeuskun. Nepeuskun is looking for volunteers to join our First Responder group, so if you know anyone interested, have them call us.

Oshkosh Fire Department responds with an Ambulance to calls in the Town of Utica. In almost all cases, we arrive at the scene before the Ambulance and begin assessing and treating the patient according to the professional training we have received. Our training is ongoing and includes working with Oshkosh Paramedics, Ripon Paramedics, other First Responder Units, and our own Utica Fire Department Firefighters. We are available to aid other EMS units surrounding us through mutual aid. We can also provide aid throughout the State and Region if called upon.

We currently have 12 active First Responders on our roster. I cannot stress enough how critical it is that we recruit more members, especially for daytime coverage. The training is paid for and all equipment is provided by the department. We are very well equipped with the tools and medications we carry with us. Our First Responders always provide our community with professional and confidential care 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
