The Town Board meets regularly the SECOND MONDAY OF EACH MONTH AT 6:00PM (unless otherwise noted). All meetings are open to the public, this is a public meeting. ### 1. Call the Meeting to Order

### 2. Discuss and act on borrowing \$80,000.00 for emergency Town road repairs, Total 2025 Road Expenditure of \$403,570.00

*(\$100,000.00 Emergency Town Road Repair loan approved at the November 11, 2024 Public Budget & Special Town Meeting Minutes)*

Chairman Schmick motions that we borrow this \$80,000 that we were granted permission to borrow; seconded by Supervisor Sawall. No discussion. Carried 2-0

### 3. Discuss and act on borrowing \$170,000.00 loan for Town expenses

Chairman Schmick stated this will be one loan for a total of \$250,000. 4.75% interest. We are required to move our accounts to this bank in order to get this rate, if we don't move our accounts to Horicon bank, it would be about a \$10,000 penalty. Deadline to move accounts from BMO to Horicon is within 4 months.





Chairman Schmick motions that we borrow the extra \$170,000 from the bank for the Town expenses; seconded by Supervisor Sawall. Carried 2-0

Chairman Schmick stated that our Town Attorney has been working with the bank directly and a letter was created stating that we are tax exempt. Chairman Schmick read the letter. We should have the funds within the first two weeks of August.
