What to Recycle

- Newspapers/magazines— Newspapers only what comes in the paper can be recycled with the papers. Keep newspapers separate from magazines.
- Cardboard/Bags Brown cardboard, brown paper bags, containers with ribbed layers, cereal, detergent boxes, NO egg carton or wax coated cardboard. Flatten all boxes.
- Glass Containers

 Jars and bottles only. No light bulbs (trash) or other glass. Remove lids, rinse clean. No need to remove labels, Keep colors separate.
- Tin Cans Food Cans ONLY. Rinse clean.
- Aluminum Cans
 — Cans ONLY; No foil or caps
- Plastic

 Only bottles marked on the bottom: (1) or (2) Soda, liquor, milk, juice, soap & shampoo
