Acceptable Items

- Pesticides, Herbicides, Insecticides, Fungicides and Rodenticides
- Poisonous repellents and banned chemicals (DDT)
- Pipeline cleaners
- Foot bath chemicals
- Fly spray for livestock
- Antifreeze
- Old gasoline
- Mothballs
- Chemical strippers
- Oil Based paints
- Varnishes
- Shellacs
- Thinners
- Lead based paints
- Aerosols
- Wood preservatives
- Oven cleaners
- Spot removers
- Acid/Bases

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- LATEX PAINT
- MOTOR OIL
- Light bulbs (Non-mercury)
- Compressed gas tanks and high pressure cylinders such as fire extinguishers and propane tanks
- Explosives such as ammunition
- Radioactive materials (smoke detectors)
- Unknown Chemicals
- Tires
- Infectious and biological water
- TVs and electronic components
- Appliances
- Freon gases (Appliances)
- Pharmaceuticals
- Batteries
- Fluorescent tubes
