1. Call to Order

- a. Chairman/Dave Stelzner called to order the Monthly meeting of Town of Weyauwega at 6:00pm on Jan 5, 2026, at The American Legion.

4. Approval of Minutes

- a. Dec Minutes: Board reviewed the minutes for Dec meeting. Motion to approve the Dec minutes by Supervisor/Terry Wilz, seconded by Supervisor/John Neuman, all ayes, motion carried.

5. Treasurers Report

- a. Treasurer/Jodi Wilz presented the treasurer's report and board reviewed. Motion to approve the Treasurer's report by Supervisor/John Neuman, seconded by Supervisor/Terry Wilz, all ayes, motion carried.

6. Review of Vouchers & Authorize Payments

- a. Approve 3 Year Renewal for Town Web: Clerk/Sonia Thede-Kramer explained the 3-year renewal contract is up for the website and emails with Town Web. The annual fee for the website and 5 emails is \$2,300. Supervisor/John Neuman advised the fee seems expensive and would like to shop. Supervisor/Terry Wilz suggested approving the 3-year renewal with Town Web and when the next contract renewal is up to shop for other options. Supervisor/John Neuman agreed he will investigate other website companies. Motion to approve and sign the 3-year contract with Town Web for website and 5 emails by Supervisor/Terry Wilz, seconded by Supervisor/John Neuman, all ayes, motion carried.
- b. Board reviewed the Vouchers & Payments report. Motion to approve vouchers and authorized payments of \$30,561.08 by Supervisor/Terry Wilz, seconded by Supervisor/John Neuman, all ayes, motion carried.

7. Joel Bartel running for Waupaca County Board

- a. Board recognized Joel Bartel. He introduced himself and he is running for Waupaca County Board member. He lives in Fremont, ran a farm in Symco and other businesses. He is running as he feels the increase in spending at the county level and could increase taxes. He does not agree with spending \$40 mil on upgrades in the county building. Feels tax money should go to items like roads, natural resources and not to sell agriculture land to foreign entities. He is running against Cindy Hardy. Supervisor/John Neuman asked who on the current board voted for the county building upgrade. Joel Bartel advised he will send over the list. Public/Joel Bartel left at 6:16pm.

- a. Wetland Rezoning & Farmland Preservation: Supervisor/John Neuman advised the next Planning Commission meeting for Wetland Rezoning & Farmland Preservation is set for 1/26/26 at 6pm.
