

**TOWN OF WHEATLAND
ORDINANCE NO. 846**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR BAR AND
GRILL LIQUOR LICENSES AND ANNUAL RENEWALS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF WHEATLAND, WYOMING:

SECTION ONE: MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: The Town of Wheatland shall only grant or renew a Bar and Grill Liquor License if the following minimum requirements are met by the applicant:

- a. The establishment/applicant has a dedicated area/ kitchen where food will be prepared completely separate and distinct from the dining area and bar area.
- b. The establishment/applicant has a menu. The menu shall include meals that cannot be conveniently consumed while standing or walking.
- c. The establishment/applicant has a dining area with dedicated tables and chairs where the meals must be served and consumed.
- d. The establishment/applicant can only be open during the time food is prepared and served.
- e. The food sales shall be at least 50% of the operation/gross sales.
- f. The establishment shall place signage on the building/property designating it as a Bar and Grill

SECTION TWO: The requirements set forth in Section One above shall be applicable to all existing Bar and Grill Liquor Licenses. Existing Bar and Grill liquor license holders are required to meet the requirements in this Ordinance before the renewal application for the year 2026.
