

ORDINANCE NO. 333

AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE ALL OF BLOCK 5 EXCEPT LOTS 1 THROUGH 65, INCLUSIVE, OF THE WHEATLAND CEMETERY AS A MEMORIAL GARDEN, SPECIFYING RESTRICTIONS ON THE ERECTION OF TOMBSTONES AND MONUMENTS AND PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF SAID LOTS WITH A RESTRICTIVE COVENANT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHEATLAND, WYOMING:

Section 1. All of Block 5 except Lots 1 through 65, inclusive, of the Wheatland Municipal Cemetery of Wheatland, Wyoming, is hereby designated as a "Memorial Garden". No tombstones, monument, vault or other grave marker shall be erected upon said described premises except individual grave markers, flush with the surface of the ground.

Section 2. As each cemetery lot or lots within said block is sold or disposed of by the Town of Wheatland, each cemetery Deed shall contain, in addition to the legal description of the lot and general requirements for deeds, the following restrictive covenant:

"As a part of the consideration for the sale of this lot (or lots), it is specifically understood and agreed between the Town of Wheatland and the grantee (or grantees) that neither the latter nor their heirs or assigns shall erect or maintain any tombstone, monument or grave marker upon the described premises except individual marker flush with the surface of the ground. It is further understood and agreed between the parties that every other deed for a cemetery lot or lots contained within Block 5 except Lots 1 through 65, inclusive, of the Wheatland Municipal Cemetery shall contain this restrictive covenant in its entirety."
