TOWN OF YORK BOARD MEETINGS: The Town Board meets on the second Monday of each month at 6:00 pm. Town meeting agendas are posted at the Town Hall and our new Town website: townofyorkwi.com.

BURNING PERMITS: Burning permits are required **WHEN THE GROUND IS NOT SNOW COVERED FROM JANUARY 1ST TO MAY 31ST**. You may obtain a "burning permit" in the Town of York from the Town Clerk. The Clerk is at the Town Hall on Fridays from 9 am to 1 pm.

PROPERTY TAXES: There are several ways to pay your tax bill. You may pay by mail, drop it off at the Town Hall drop box to the left of the entrance door or stop in at the Town Hall on Fridays between 9 am and 1:00 pm. When mailing your tax bill, **if you would like a receipt, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope. Checks that include both tax payments and dog licenses will be returned to you. Separate checks are required for tax payments and dog licenses.**

DOG LICENSES/TAGS: ALL dog owners (this includes both property owners and renters) living within the Town of York are **required** to obtain a current year dog license. This applies to dogs 5 months of age or older, both house dogs and outside dogs. Unlicensed and untagged dogs will be picked up for disposal if running loose and at large. When applying for a dog license, you must provide a **current rabies certificate** at that time per State law. Please contact the Clerk/Treasurer at (608) 445-7941 if you have any questions about dog licenses. A dog licensing application is on the back of this newsletter.

The cost for a spayed or neutered dog is \$18.75 and \$27.75 for dogs that have not been spayed or neutered. **IF APPLYING BY MAIL, PLEASE ENCLOSE A SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE TO RETURN YOUR TAGS AND LICENSE TO YOU.** Protect your dog(s) by having them licensed.

2026 ELECTIONS: Spring Primary (If Needed) – February 17, 2026; Spring General Election – April 7, 2026; Fall Primary - August 11, 2026 and Fall General Election - November 7, 2026.

THE TOWN OF YORK RECYCLING CENTER is open on Saturdays from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM and is open to all residents of the Town of York. Items that are recyclable are metal, glass, tin, paper, cardboard, #1 to #7 plastic. Items that are **NOT** accepted include furniture, carpet, construction materials, roofing, grass clippings and brush. Private disposal may also be contracted. The operator at the Recycling Center will be able to assist you in determining what is recyclable. It is free to dispose of your recyclables. There is a charge for other trash. A 30-gallon or less garbage bag is \$3.00 and a 55-gallon barrel is \$6.00. A punch card with 10 punches is \$30.00. All garbage must be in a bag. Recyclables must be loose, not in a bag and must be rinsed and clean.

The Town of York now has a building fee. The fee is \$40.00 and is payable for all new structures, additions and remodels. Please contact the Clerk for more information or to pay this fee.
