

TOWN OF YORK, DANE COUNTY  
MINUTES – March 9, 2026

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of York was called to order by Chairman Helwig at 6:00 pm on Monday, March 9, 2026. Those present were Chairman Helwig, Supervisor Auchtung, Supervisor Derr and Linda Henning, Clerk/Treasurer. Others present: Listed on the sign-in sheet attached to the original minutes.

Public Comment: Jeff Weigand candidate for Dane County Board attended the meeting to introduce himself and answer questions.

Posting of the agenda and meeting notice was verified by the Clerk/Treasurer.

Approval of the agenda: Motion by Supervisor Auchtung with a second from Supervisor Derr to approve of the agenda as posted. Agenda approved with all present in favor.

Minutes of February 9th, 2026: Motion by Supervisor Derr with a second from Supervisor Auchtung to approve of the minutes of February 9th, 2026, Town Board meeting. Minutes approved with all present in favor.

Clerk's Report: There were 51 voters who cast their ballot at the Spring primary election.

Treasurer's Report: The monthly Treasurer's report showed the following in Town accounts. Farmers & Merchants Union Bank - \$89,238.07 in the general account and \$167,522.66 in the savings account. There was \$34,026.29 in the LGIP General account and \$8,743.67.65 in the LGIP Cemetery account.

Bills to pay were approved on a motion by Supervisor Derr with a second from Supervisor Auchtung. Checks approved for payment were #9525 thru #9549 including Electronic Funds Payments for utilities and payroll liabilities. Motion approved with all present in favor.

Patrolman's Report: Patrolman Dan Kleven had gotten bids for broom and fork attachments for the loader tractor. These will be purchased for a total cost of \$9600.00.

Historical Committee: They have been researching cemetery software and have decided they want to purchase a subscription to Everspot Cemetery software at \$40.00 per month.

Comprehensive Plan Update Committee: The Committee is recommending to the Board that the Public Participation Plan and Resolution 2026-01 be approved by the Town Board so to further the Committees goal of updating the current Town plan. Motion by Supervisor Derr with a second from Supervisor Auchtung to approve Resolution 2026-01 regarding updating the Town's Comprehensive Plan. Motion approved with all present in favor.

There is Board of Review training this Saturday for Board members.

Chairman's Report: The Marshall Fire Department has sold one of their brush trucks.

Representatives from the Capital Area Regional Commission (CARPC) were present to deliver a presentation regarding culverts in the Town of York as well as funding from the WISDOT for Local Small Structures Improvement Program (LSSP).

The next meeting is April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Reminder of the Town Annual Meeting – 4/21/26 at 7 pm

There being no further business on the agenda, motion by Supervisor Auchtung with a second from Supervisor Derr to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 7:48 pm.
