 - b. Raschein rezone parcels 034-0363-10000 & 034-0352-01000 The following rezone criteria were considered:
 - i. The proposed amendment is consistent with the overall purpose and intent of the Comprehensive Plan *YES*
 - ii. The proposed amendment is consistent with the Town's Future Land Use Map YES
 - iii. Factors have changed since the last comprehensive plan and map adoption that warrants the change -YES
 - iv. If rezoning land out of an agricultural district, the board shall find all the following:
 - 1. The land is better for non-agricultural use YES
 - 2. The rezone is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan YES
 - 3. The rezone is consistent with the Farmland Preservation Plan YES
 - 4. The rezone will not substantially impair or limit current or future agricultural use of surrounding parcels of land zoned for agriculture *YES*
 - v. Tim Bruckert moved, Franzen second, to approve the rezone of parcels 034-0363-10000 & 034-0352-01000 from agricultural to single family residence. There were (3) Yea votes (Franzen, Richards, Tim Bruckert) and (2) Nay votes (Josh Bruckert, Doug Gjertson). Motion carried by majority vote.
