Dear Property Owner,

In accordance with Mount Holly Township Ordinance # 2013-05, effective April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013, all vacant or abandoned properties, regardless if for residential or for business use, are mandated to be registered with the Township's Code Enforcement Officials.

Consequently, there is a Township Ordinance Violation Notice attached with this letter. You must comply with said registration within the time period noted on the violation. Failure to comply will result in a summons being issued with a date to appear in Municipal Court. For your convenience enclosed is a blank form to facilitate the registration with the fees listed.

You are being sent this notice as you are listed on the tax records as the legal owner. If you are no longer the legal owner of the property in question, then you are obligated to provide proof of change of ownership in the form of a legal document within 5 business days of receiving this notice otherwise a summons will be issued to you to appear in Municipal Court.
