Public Works Reminders

- Your **water softener hardness** should be 22.1 (grains per gallon.) Please set them accordingly.
- **Brush pick-up** is the second Monday each month from April – November. Ordinance 6.32 Please keep the brush out of the road and on the curb.
- **Leaves and other debris:** Leaves and grass clippings need to stay on your lawn, not in the road. They can clog up the storm and sewer drain, which causes flooding.
- **Garbage bins** need to be placed on the terrace or grass not in the road. They need to be 2 to 3 feet apart for pick up. This allows for street cleaning and snow plowing.
- Ordinance 10.07 states that there is a **72-hour parking Limitation** on village streets. Just a reminder to move your vehicles.
- **Property Maintenance:** Grass and noxious weeds may not reach over 8” in length. If they do, a letter from the Village will be sent and you will have ten days to remedy the situation. The Village also has ordinances regarding exterior storage, unregistered vehicles, recreational vehicles (Boats, campers, and trailers.) Please be considerate of your neighbors and keep your property clean and tidy.
- **Reagles Street Project:** This project is set to begin in April. we are sorry for the inconvenience and appreciate your patience while this project is completed.

Village Board/Office Reminders

- **Renters/Property Owners:** When you or you have a tenant moving out, please notify the Village for a **FINAL READ**. We need to document with the final read when a person is no longer responsible for the utility bill.
- **Water Meters:** As many of you may have noticed, the new meters and the radios have been going up around town. Please be on the lookout for a letter in the mail, or a door hanger, to set up an appointment to get yours changed out. Once you get this notice, please respond as soon as possible.
- **Elections:** We have our Spring Election on April 7th, 2026. Please note that voting hours are from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm.
- **Flags on Main Street:** We are looking to keep the flags on Main Street through the summer; to keep the sense of pride and beauty to our community- and we'd love your help! If you or your business would like to contribute toward maintaining flags, any donation is greatly appreciated. With the wind of this beautiful Prairie, the flags have a hard time holding up for long before they are ripped or torn and need to be replaced.
- **DUMPSTER DAY:** The Village of Arlington is holding our dumpster day, down at the Village Hall, on Saturday, May 16th from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM or until the dumpsters are full. You cannot bring electronics or recycling products.
- **Drug Take Back:** There will be a drug take back day on April 25th at the Village Hall. You are able to bring needles, old medications – liquid or pills, in the bottles or out of the bottles.
