Village of Black Creek Resolution #2021-7 Ward Resolution

WHEREAS, all cities, villages and towns with a population of 1,000 or more must establish municipal wards based on the results of the decennial federal census of population as required in § 5.15, WI Statutes; and

WHEREAS, each County Board must adopt and transmit to each municipal governing body in the county a tentative county supervisory district plan, dividing the county into districts and designating the approximate location and population of each ward proposed to effectuate the division of the county into districts as required in § 59.10(3)(b), WI Statutes; and

WHEREAS, these laws require the governing body of each municipality, within sixty (60) days upon receipt of the adopted tentative supervisory redistrict plan, to create election wards or adjust existing ward lines to accommodate the creation of supervisory districts and to number each ward accordingly by consecutive whole number beginning with the number one (1) through adoption of a resolution; and

WHEREAS, Outagamie County has provided the Village of Black Creek a tentative county supervisory district plan subsequent to the 2020 decennial federal census completion encompassing the entire geographical area of the Village of Black Creek;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public that the Village of Black Creek be divided into Ward 1 and Ward 2. Ward 1 is to be the North side of Burdick Street and all properties to the North. Ward 2 is to be the South side of Burdick Street and all properties to the South.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Village Board of the Village of Black Creek in Outagamie County that the village ordinance be passed which will establish Ward 1 and Ward 2 in the Village of Black Creek in Outagamie County as follows:


