The history of April Fool's Day, sometimes called All Fool's Day, is not totally clear. There really wasn't a "first April Fool's Day" that can be pinpointed

on the calendar. Some believe it sort of evolved simultaneously in several cultures at the same time, from celebrations involving the first day of spring.

The closest point in time that can be identified as the beginning of this tradition was in 1582, in France. Prior to that year, the new year was celebrated for eight days, beginning on March 25. The celebration culminated on April 1. With the reform of the calendar under Charles IX, the Gregorian Calendar was introduced, and New Year's Day was moved to January 1.

However, communications being what they were in the days when news traveled by foot, many people did not receive the news for several years. Others, the more obstinate crowd, refused to accept the new calendar and continued to celebrate the new year on April 1. These backward folk were labeled as "fools" by the general populace. They were subject to some ridicule, and were often sent on "fools errands" or were made the butt of other practical jokes.

2010 Yard Waste Collection

- 🗑 All yard waste must be placed at the curb by Monday morning at 10:00 am in order to be collected by the maintenance staff.
- 🗑 Branches must be bundled and tied (no wire) together in bundles of no more than 3 feet in length and cannot exceed 50 lbs.
- 🗑 Only include leaves, grass clippings, yard waste and small branches (bundled as outlined above).
- 🗑 Yard waste must be in paper bags and/or a container that can be dumped into the truck.
- 🗑 Bags/containers cannot weigh more than 50 lbs.
- 🗑 If you have a branch/yard waste that exceeds the 50 lb limit, please call the office, 262-857-2891, by 5:00 on the Friday prior to pick-up.
- 🗑 Yard waste collection will continue every Monday morning until further notice.
