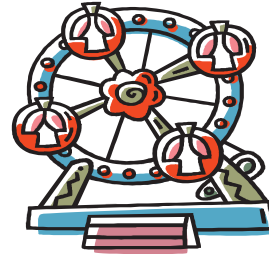

The Bristol Fire Department is accepting applications for paid-on-call premise firefighter/EMT, EMT/I-99 or Paramedic. Bristol residents that are interested should fill out an application and we will train you for the positions available.

Fireworks Prohibited in the Village—Ordinance 7-5-1

The sale of fireworks or the possession of fireworks with intent to sell within the Village of Bristol is hereby prohibited. "Fireworks" means anything manufactured, processed or packaged for exploding, emitting sparks or combustion which does not have another common use.

Always Remember to...

Get your burn permit if you have not done so already. The initial permit is \$25 and to renew your permit is \$15. You must also remember to follow the guidelines that are on the permit as conditions can change during the day. And, "Be kind to your neighbors when burning."

Having A Father's Day Cookout? Be safe when using your grill

To ensure safe cookouts, make sure someone tends the grill at all times. Here are some grilling safety tips to consider:

- Keep grills away from combustibles, including the outside of your house, balcony or garage.
- Check hose integrity and hose connections to make sure gas is not leaking from your gas grill. Apply soapy water to hoses and connections to reveal any leaks.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions on how to set up the grill and maintain it.
- Never store propane cylinders in buildings or garages. If you store a gas grill inside during the winter, disconnect the cylinder and leave it outside.
- Enforce a "kid-free zone" of 36" around the grill. Also keep your pets from getting underfoot.
- Never add charcoal starter fluid when coals or kindling have already been ignited, and never use any flammable or combustible liquid other than charcoal starter fluid to get the fire going.
- Keep the grill clean.
